Manifest MedEx Background

Manifest MedEx (MX) is a health information exchange in California helping physicians, hospitals and health plans meet their goals of improving care, reducing costs and enhancing health. As the largest nonprofit health data network in California, Manifest MedEx shares health records for 25 million Californians and supports HIE services for over 800 health care organizations, ambulatory practices, health plans, county agencies, and over 120 hospitals. MX is currently connected with 8 health plans in California. MX brings together both claims and clinical data to enable access to longitudinal patient records, real-time event notifications, reporting, and advanced analytics. It is one of few HIEs nationally that is HITRUST certified.

In 2021, MX is expanding our ambulatory care footprint in California. Community providers patients navigate transitions in care, manage chronic conditions, avoid hospital readmissions, access preventive services and manage medications. They are leaders in value-based models, such as accountable care organizations, yet they often lack key insights about the care patients receive outside the clinic. MX aims to onboard over 500 ambulatory care groups by the end of July 2021. Medical groups and practices receive MX services free of charge.

Overview of Initiative

Manifest MedEx is seeking to hire multiple subcontractor organizations to recruit and enroll ambulatory groups and practices in the Manifest MedEx HIE and Cal-HOP grant program.

Cal-HOP is a state and federally funded grant program to expand Medicaid provider participation in a Health Information Exchange (i.e., Manifest MedEx) to improve care coordination, reduce readmissions and reduce costs. When new participants connect their data to MX, they automatically complete the Cal-HOP program milestones.

MX is looking for subcontractors that can rapidly sign-up providers in specific regions of California not currently covered by MX's current recruitment partners. Subcontractors will be considered representatives of MX in the field and in doctor's practices

MX will pay subcontractors \$5,000 for each eligible medical group or practice recruited, defined as receipt of a complete, signed **MX Ambulatory Contracting Packet** and signed **Cal-HOP letter of intent (LOI)** by August 2021.

MX will support awarded subcontractors in their outreach efforts by providing them with:

- Onboarding training and background on MX
- Marketing materials and templates
- Bi-weekly meetings discuss questions, progress, and risks

Once a practice has been recruited, the subcontractor will hand off the practice to the MX Implementation team who will work to connect the practice's data to the MX platform. The MX Customer Success team will provide training and onboarding.

Ambulatory Practice and Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) Eligibility

To be eligible, ambulatory practices and SNFs must meet the following requirements:

1. Have a valid contract with DHCS, a Medicaid Managed Care Organization, or other entity authorized to bill for care for Medi-Cal patients. For the purposes of this section, other entities may include an Independent Physician's Association (IPA) or a Health Center Controlled Network (HCCN), or
 - o Practices identified as a priority by MX
2. Ambulatory practices are limited to the 9 counties listed below:
 1. Fresno
 2. Imperial
 3. Los Angeles
 4. Madera
 5. Orange
 6. Sacramento
 7. San Diego
 8. San Joaquin

3. Practice must use an EHR vendor from the approved list below:

To support recruitment, MX is also providing limited-time incentives to ambulatory practices after successful enrollment as defined above. Incentives are based on the number of full-time (30+ hours/week) providers (MD, PA, DO, or NP) at the practice:

- 1-2 providers: \$3,000
- 3-10 providers: \$6,000
- 11+ providers or SNF practice: \$8,000

To receive the incentive, the practice must complete the following steps by August 30, 2021:

- Complete required data connections with MX Implementation team,
- Sign the attestation form for Cal-HOP,
- Complete the onboarding process with the MX Customer Success team.

MX will issue payment after MX receives Cal-HOP payment for completed data connections.

Participation in MX is free for practices.

Subcontractor Performance

MX will regularly evaluate subcontractor's performance on the following criteria:

- Performance achieving recruitment goals in their given region/regions
- Timeliness, completeness and accuracy of MX Ambulatory Contracting Packet
- Professionalism and integrity of interactions
- Communication on HIE, MX and Cal-HOP

Underperforming subcontractors may be terminated at the discretion of MX. MX may reissue this RFP or contract with additional subcontractors to ensure geographical coverage across the state or achieve other goals.

Objective of this RFP

The objective of this RFP is to identify organizations interested in contracting with MX to recruit ambulatory medical groups and practices. MX will assess the subcontractor organizations that reply to this RFP on their HIE knowledge, credibility, experience working with ambulatory practices on similar programs, and ability to recruit eligible practices.

To be eligible for consideration, candidate subcontractor organizations should submit a proposal by the deadline with the following information:

- Organization overview
- Key personnel

- Past experience
- Project plan
- Target regions and practices

Eligible Subcontractors

MX is requiring subcontractors be California-based companies. Subcontracting organizations could include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Organizations with extensive experience in the California market providing services to medical groups and practices related to:
 - Health information technology adoption and use
 - State or federal quality improvement efforts
 - Practice transformation
 - EHR adoption, Meaningful Use, HIE onboarding, and/or value-based payment arrangement adoption
- Medical associations and societies

Organizations are not eligible to be a subcontractor if they meet any of the following conditions:

- are currently engaged in another recruitment effort with MX
- are a hospital or health system

MX may also exclude organizations that directly receive funding from the Cal-HOP program.
