

## Release Notes: MX Portal V1.10



The MX portal was upgraded on 4/13/19. Below are the release notes for version V1.10.

**TABLE 1: SUMMARY OF CHANGES**

Item Number	Summary	Description
1	Enhancement Request: “Contact Us” webpage field alignment	When clicking on “User Support” in the MX Platform, users are brought to the “Contact Us” webpage. The webpage now has all fields aligned, making it easier to read.
2	Data Defect: Update the “Relationship” name in the next of kin tab	In the next of kin tab, the “Relationship” field displays the full name (i.e., Spouse) rather than the abbreviation (i.e., SPO) for better clarification.
