The MX portal was upgraded on 1/19/19. Below are the release notes for version V1.4.




1	Feature Enhancement: Admit source	Driver's License State is displayed next to Driver's License Number

1.2	Feature Enhancement: Encounter on patient summary page	The Patient Summary page includes a preview of Encounters
1.3	Feature Enhancement: Diagnosis order	Diagnoses are listed in reverse chronological order
1.4	Feature Enhancement: PCP in demographics	The primary care provider is included in patient demographics

1.6	Feature Enhancement: Patient context from Notify to Access	When viewing a notification, users can click on Access to view that patient's medical record
